What's happening in term 4?

Maths

This term, we'll be brushing up on our number skills, place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, and fractions. We'll also be diving into exciting mathematical investigations that will have us exploring chance, time, money and measurement. We will use our problem-solving skills, working together to crack some challenging puzzles!

Literacy

The start of this term sees us revisiting narrative writing, learning how to plan and create engaging stories. We will then take a deep dive into poetry, creating some works of our own! We'll end our term with a focus on letter writing. Our daily literacy programme will continue to focus on building awareness of letters and sounds via our structured literacy programme.
