## WHAT'S HAPPENING THIS TERM

#### Costume Making

This year for Book Week we will be encouraging all children within our kura to make their own character costume to wear on dress up day to celebrate Book Week.

We want to pump this among our senior children. It would be great to hear of children discussing ideas for costumes with whānau and whānau encouraging them to collect supplies at home to support their costume design and creation at school.

### Swimming

During week 3, all our Ngahere children will be participating in structured swimming lessons down at Te Rauparaha Arena.

It is essential that all children have their togs, towel and goggles (optional) to actively participate on the 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th May.

There is no cost for whānau for this; however, we do expect that all children will be in the water as we know that learning how to swim and be safe within and around water is an important life skill to have.

#### Topic Inquiries

This term we will focus on two topic inquiries; Aotearoa Histories and Food for Thought (Food Nutrition).

Our planning of fun, interactive and critical thinking activities are well underway and we look forward to exploring both of these topics in classes with our tamariki. Be sure to look out for their key learning displayed on Seesaw!

#### Homework

The expectations of homework are listed below:

Maths-Whizz - 3x 15 minute sessions a week on top of what your child does in class. If this isn't possible at home we can accommodate by making computers available before school.

Reading daily - We encourage your child to read daily at home with personal choice books. Regular reading is what makes great readers. The importance of this can't be emphasised enough. It is free to sign up to the Porirua public library, which allows you access to a wide range of books to enjoy.

#### KURA Kowhiri

Back by popular demand in Term 2 with a new name are Flectives now known as KURA Kōwhiri. This will happen during weeks 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 on Fridays. Children will have opportunity to make their selection early in term 2. We know they will have a lot of fun participating in their chosen option, as it allows them to try something that might be new to them, something that is a passion of theirs as well as allowing time for them to work with and alongside other teachers and tamariki.

#### Seesaw

During the term your child will share posts about what they are doing in class, in a range of curriculum areas. Whole school Seesaw reporting will look like:

**Term 1 & 3** - Reading & Writing post showing photographic evidence of your child's learning

**Term 2 & 4** - Maths post showing photographic evidence of your child's learning.

A levelled report will be posted on Seesaw for each child at the end of Term 2 and 4. This will show your child's levels in Reading, Writing and Maths, as well as a general comment from their teacher.
